2. <p>Recent scholarly research on authoritarianism of the first half of the 20th century has been giving special attention to the transnational collaborative networks that the European fascist states successfully created during the period.</p> <p>Drawing on this type of approach and focusing therefore on the international linkage of these otherwise deeply parochial regimes, the seminar will specifically address both the institutional and non-institutional German-Portuguese bilateral interactions from around 1933 to the end of the Second World War. The course will thus explore the diplomatic relations between the two countries, the political and ideological convergences and divergences of the two regimes, but also the cultural, scientific and private communication channels that ensure the flow of information and hence the stability of these networks.</p>
