#### Job summary:

A call is now open for one research grant (BI) for holders of a Masters degree for the development of research within the scope of the project "Present Democracy for Future Generations" (reference PTDC/FER-FIL/6088/2020), financed by the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology (FCT/MCTES), in accordance with the following terms:

#### Job description:

1. Area of research: Political Theory and/or any related area
  2. Addressees: The BI is for candidates enrolled in a PhD course offered by the NOVA University of Lisbon.
  3. Applicant admission requirements: Can apply for the Scholarship those who are:
    - Portuguese citizens or citizens of other member states of the European Union;
    - Citizens of other states outside the EU;
    - Stateless persons;
    - Citizens with political refugee status.
- To apply for the BI, it is necessary to:
- Have an MA Degree;
  - Be enrolled in a PhD program offered by the NOVA University of Lisbon;
  - Be residing in Portugal full-time during the Masters, which is a requirement applicable to both national and international citizens.
4. Application Admission Requirements: It is essential to include the following documents in your application:
    - Curriculum vitae;
    - Certificates of academic degrees held;
    - Proof of enrolment in a PhD course offered by the NOVA University of Lisbon;
    - One letter of recommendation;
    - Motivation letter, containing a description of the goals within the work plan (1,000 words max.).

Only candidates who have completed the cycle of studies leading to the MA degree will be admitted by the end of the application period. If they do not yet have the certificate of completion of the course, a declaration from the candidates will be accepted to show that they completed the necessary qualifications by the end of the application period. The scholarship is always dependent on the presentation of proof of the academic qualifications required for the scholarship.

Important notice to candidates who hold diplomas issued by foreign higher education institutions: the research grant will be attributed to candidates with diplomas issued by foreign higher education institutions only upon presentation of proof of recognition of academic degrees and the conversion of the final classification. The recognition of foreign academic degrees and diplomas as well as the conversion of the final classification to the Portuguese classification scale can be required in any public higher education institution, or in the Directorate-General for Higher Education (DGES). 5. Work plan: The grant holder will tackle issues of intergenerational justice in democratic environments or analyse key concepts of modern democratic theory, mostly by testing whether their time horizons can expand in order to encompass the distant future.

6. Applicable legislation and regulations: Research Fellow Status; Regulation of Research Grants of the Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.

7. Workplace: The work will be carried out at the NOVA Institute of Philosophy (IFILNOVA) at the Faculty of Social and Human Sciences of the NOVA University of Lisbon, under the scientific supervision of Research Fellow André Santos Campos.

8. Duration of the scholarship: The duration of the scholarships is of 6 months, renewable up to a maximum of 30 months. Scheduled to start in October 2021.

9. Scholarship amount: The scholarship amount is €1104,64 per month (according to the table of scholarship values directly attributed by FCT, I.P. in the country) (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>).

10. Selection methods: The evaluation takes into account the candidate's application and qualifications, the letter of motivation, and the letter of recommendation.

Applications considered admissible will be scored on a scale of 1 to 20 in each of the following evaluation criteria:

- Criterion A – Merit of the applicant (50%)
  - o Subcriterion A1 – Scientific, cultural or technological production (books, book chapters, theses, papers in indexed journals, presentations in national and international scientific events) (30%)
  - o Subcriterion A2 – Participation in scientific projects (10%)
  - o Subcriterion A3 – Organization of scientific events (5%)
  - o Subcriterion A4 – Recognition of the scientific community (awards, fellowships, editorial activities, peer reviewing) (5%)
- Criterion B – Motivation letter (40%)
- Criterion C – Letter of recommendation (10%).

In the possible case of a tie-break, candidates will be ranked according to the ratings assigned to each of the evaluation criteria in the following order of precedence: criterion A, criterion B, criterion C.

Candidates whose application is evaluated with a final classification below 16 points are not eligible for the scholarship.

12. Form of publication / results notifications: The results of the evaluation are communicated via email to the email address of the candidate indicated in the application.

13. Application deadline: The competition is open between 6th July 2021 and 23:59 (Lisbon time) on 19th July 2021.
